- 1 A membership card will not be issued until payment and an electronic version of your photograph has been received. It should also be noted that members will not be allowed to practice without production of their membership card. A special membership desk will be available on 4th/5th January 2020 practice weekend and at the March 2020 race meeting.
- 2 All junior members are required to have at least one parent or guardian join the club as a social member and your membership will not be valid until it is paid in full and a membership card has been issued bearing your photograph. You are required to present this at all practice sessions.
