

**WSKC-IKR OCTOBER MEETING**  
**FINAL INSTRUCTIONS & INFORMATION**

Welcome to Larkhall Circuit for Round 5 of the WSKC-IKR Club Championship and WSKC Scottish Open. This event is closed to the public and only those registered may attend.

There are some important changes ahead of this meeting so please read below.

- **WRISTBANDS** – For those of you who race at TVKC this will be common practice, however all please read this.  
**WSKC-IKR** have a duty to control the flow of people in busier areas of the venue, we have always even before covid request 1 Driver 1 Mechanic in parc ferme area's and assembly areas. We now have an obligation to enforce this, on Saturday you must attend Race Control between 9 and 9.30am, where for every entrant 1 wristband will be issued for use of the mechanic of that entrant. Without having the wristband on you will not be permitted access to the assembly area's or parc-ferme – if you miss a session due to forgetting it or not collecting your band WSKC is not liable it Is your responsibility to collect this and wear it. For those only attending on Sunday (different wristband) you can collect your wristband between 8.30am and 9am at Race Control. Should you damage or lose your wristband a non-waivable fee of £5 will be charged for replacement.
- **DRIVERS BRIEFING** – As is the case under all Motorsport UK events we are trying to reduce area's of congregation, drivers briefing is now online format on alpha and will be emailed alongside this document, it is your duty to read it.
- **DUMMY GRID GATES** – Access to the dummy grid should be made 2minutes before the completion of the on circuit race, this is to ensure everyone is lined up and ready to go and to stop the mixing of different classes on the dummy grid, Pole should line up on the left hand side of the dummy grid, 2<sup>nd</sup> place on the right hand side. If you are late to the gates you will not be given access and you will miss your race. Only one class on the Dummy Grid at a time, the next class should line up next to the containers at the entrance to the Dummy Grid and wait for the gates to open. Please respect our Dummy Grid marshal's.
- **COVID-19** – You are all aware of the requirements to wear masks in all areas of the venue except your own pit bay. This includes all children from the age of 5 upwards. You should keep your helmet on until back in your pit bay and/or when leaving your pit bay. During these times we need everyone to follow this fully, it is a send home offence to fail to comply. Maximum of 1 attendees plus an entrant – we will be extra firm on this - exceptions will be permitted\*, this weekend as we are at capacity for those permitted to be at the venue.
- **GRIDS & TIMETABLE** – This will be attached and is always subject to change due to on circuit incidents, Please follow what is on circuit and any

announcements, the responsibility is on you to ensure you are in the right place at the right time.

- **The GANTRY** – This continues to be an area of concern, there is clear signage of 8 maximum being permitted on this at social distancing levels of 2metres, our gate/gantry marshal and COVID-19 marshal was ignored on several occasions at the last round, the club will make this simple from now on: if you are instructed to leave the gantry and you do not do so immediately at this round you will be sent home without right of appeal including your driver, only mechanics with wristbands are permitted on the gantry on both Saturday & Sunday.  
**Children/Competitors should not go on the gantry.**
- **The KR Café** – While in the most recent announcement café's can remain open, due to the numbers at the venue we would encourage all entrants to pay by card.
- **Toilets** – Maximum of 2 persons in these areas at any one time, please wear face coverings and wash your hands – You do not need to sing happy birthday as per Mr Johnsons suggestion.
- **Tyre Scanning** – ALL CLASSES Tyres (slicks/Bambino) must be brought for tyre scanning EVEN IF you have entered them online, this is due to system changes, all tyres must be scanned by 8.45am on Race Morning latest – No tyres scanned? This is a technical non-compliance. No tyre scanning is available on Saturday. You should come with your tyres, place them on the bench take a step back 2 metres and allow the Scrutineer to scan them, they will then tell you to collect them. Please do not leave this to last minute to ensure overcrowding of the Scrutineering bay does not occur.

We hope you have an enjoyable and safe weekend, please follow this document and the attached carefully so we can ensure the event is run safely and in accordance with the latest COVID-19 restrictions.
